You will walk to your classrooms through the main entrance gate. (1)



You will follow the path along the edge of the carpark (2) and past the **fences**(3)



and then go in through the main entrance, where the office is. (4) you will see one LSA on your journey to direct you to the classrooms.



You need to carry on and go past the office, through the doors, past the toilets and down the Year 3 and 4 corridor. (5)



One person like your parent, grandparent or older brother or sister can walk you to the main entrance if you want to or they can say goodbye at the gate.



You will walk past the office; Walk down the hallway to find your locker and your classrooms.

You can put your coat, bag, and lunch box in your locker.
