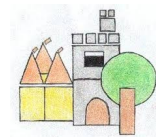

All jewellery must be removed.

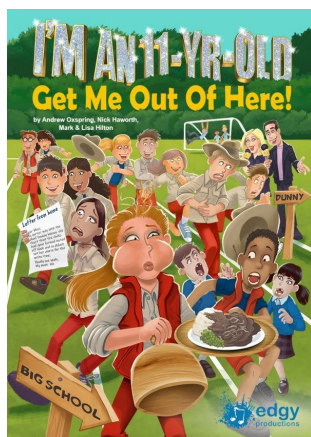


Production!
