Universal Support

Identify children who may need individual equipment such as ear defenders, wobble cushions, pencil grips etc
Adaptions needed for learning are in place
Ensure Ordinarily Available Documents have been followed
Early Interventions eg sensory circuits as required
Staff complete ROC and discuss this with parents and SENDCo (Two terms of evidence ideally required)
