Children should still wear their PE kits to school.

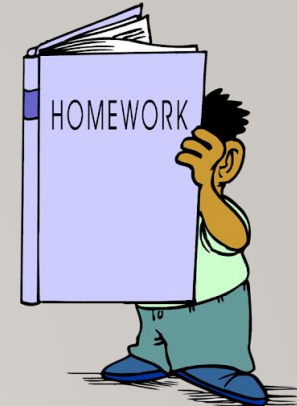
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## **Homework**

We do expect children to also read regularly and practice their times tables.

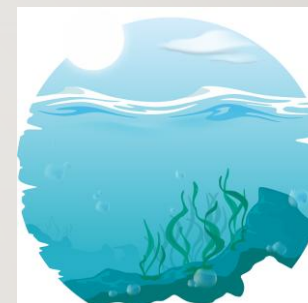


## **Library**

## **Reading**

Reading daily with your child has a significant impact, and we encourage daily reading as often as possible.

The children will take Star Tests to assess them and generate their new level for their library books.

## **Multiplication Tables Check**

In Year 4, your children will be taking the Multiplication Check in Term 6.

They need to answer 25 times tables questions, but they will only have 6 seconds per question.

It is so important that your children are confident with their times tables by the end of the year, so please practice them regularly at home.
