Please send the book in every day, whether your child has read or not. Books will be changed once a week. In addition to this, they will visit the school library every Thursday morning to chose a book to bring home. They should return the book to school for the following Thursday.


Here are some questions to ask your child when they read , to help develop their understanding of books and their comprehension.
