<u>Friday Club –</u> We'd like to take this opportunity to remind you that Friday club is only for the children of those parents who are in work on a Friday afternoon and do not have access to any other childcare arrangements. We are consistently over-subscribed for places and we must ensure that they are being offered to those who have a genuine need. We expect children to attend regularly and not 'drop in and out', as this causes difficulties for planning, resourcing and staffing the sessions. We expect children to stay for the full club i.e. until **3.10pm**. We review attendance every term and will remove the













offer of the space if it is appearing from the lack of attendance that other arrangements are available to the family. Thank you for your support with this.



Collection of pupils at the end of the day REMINDER - We'd like to take this opportunity to remind you that, if there are any changes in collection arrangements at the end of the day, you must let us know in writing. If it's a one-off, on the day change, a message in your child's contact book is fine or you can, of course, email the office who will pass the message on. It can be tricky for you to pass a message on to the teacher on duty in the morning as it's such a busy time, so a written note or message left with the office is always best.

If it's a more permanent arrangement i.e. a family member or close friend will be meeting your child regularly at the end of the day, please send in a letter or email, or call the office. We will need the person's name and a contact number for them.

Emergency contact numbers - It is essential that we have at least 2 emergency contacts for your child. If we currently only have 1, please log on to Arbor and update your records. If this is going to cause difficulties, please speak to a member of the Office Team.

We have been asked to share the following information with you from Medway Public Health - MMR vaccine catch-up clinics running this April and May. Make sure your child is protected from measles

Following a rise in measles cases in London and England, the NHS are urging parents and carers to make sure their children are up-to-date with their MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) vaccinations. To do this you can check your child's red book, or check with

your GP, who can offer MMR catch-up appointments. <u>Measles</u> can lead to serious illness but it is preventable through two doses of the MMR vaccine.

Catch-up clinics are available to school-aged children, and teens up 19 years old, on Saturday, 27 April and Saturday 18 May at the Clover Street Clinic in Chatham.
