Celebrations

Our topic this term is Celebrations! We will be learning about different special occasions, including Bonfire Night, Christmas, and other important celebrations from around the world.

Reading

By now you and your child should be familiar with the routine of reading books. The children have been learning how to sound out and blend to read words. They may find the skill of blending quite challenging so continue with lots of oral blending at home, modelling and blending the sounds together will be needed at this stage. Please could you sign the reading record book and write a comment when your child has read. We will continue to change reading books once a week on a Friday and children will be reading with a member of staff 1:1 at least once a week. Please ensure that both the reading record and the reading book are in school throughout the week so we are able to hear your child read and write a comment in the reading record.

Library

We will continue to go to the library every Monday. The children really enjoy choosing new books to take home and share with their families. Please remember to return library books each Monday so your child can borrow a new one. Thank you for helping to foster a love of reading at home!

Phonics

We hope you are still finding the phonics resources useful at home. We are sure you will agree that the children are making amazing progress with their phonics and reading. We will continue to let you know each Friday via Dojo which sounds, words and harder to read and spell words we have covered through the week so that you can embed this learning at home.

Nativity

Year R Nativity performances will be on Tuesday 9th December, in the afternoon. Times will follow in due course so please look out for this. We will be allocating parts over the few weeks and sending home information about costumes that we may need some help to provide for the children. We do have a small supply of costumes available to borrow so we will organise a time when parents can pop in after school to see if there is something of use.
